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In an attempt to discourage the spread of childhood diseases throughout the hospital community, we require ALL volunteers to provide documentation of specific vaccinations.

All volunteers will be required to provide documentation of the TDaP booster. This vaccination protects against diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis.

Regarding measles vaccination, Connecticut Children's Medical Center requires that all volunteers born on or after January 1, 1957, provide documentation of having been; 1) infected with measles or, 2) Having received the MMR vaccine or measles vaccine twice after January 1, 1969 at 15 months of age or older.

Volunteers joining Connecticut Children's Medical Center during flu season (October 1 – December 31) will be required to show documentation of influenza vaccination as well. All volunteers are required to have annual influenza vaccinations and will receive a hang tag for their badge each year to ensure compliance.
